WHAT IS THE GLENCOE GRAND PRIX?

It is a one-day cycling event featuring local amateurs and professional cyclists from all over the world.

WHERE IS THE RACE COURSE?

The race track is a 1.3 mile, 10-corner course through the streets of downtown Glencoe. It is referred to as a "criterium" race, which is a road race form of cycling.

WHO RIDES?

Hundreds of cyclists from amateur hobbyists who just ride locally, to women's and men's professional riders from all over the country and the world. Ages range to as young as 10 to a masters category of 45 years of age and older.

THIS IS A PROFESSIONAL RACE? WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

The Glencoe Grand Prix is an event sanctioned by USA Cycling, the national governing body of professional cycling. This race is part of the National Racing Calendar, the US tour for pro riders. This year, the event will also be host to the Illinois Criterium Championship, which is the state's most prestigious criterium race.
